TRANSLATION. ORIGINAL TEXT IN FINNISH.

Exemption from safety licence for the use of equipment that generates ionising radiation electrically when the equipment operates at a maximum voltage of 5 kV

By virtue of Section 17, paragraph 1, point 3 of the Radiation Act (592/1991), the Radiation and Nuclear Safety Authority has decided that a safety licence is not required for the use of equipment that generates ionising radiation electrically if the equipment operates at a maximum voltage of 5 kV.

This decision concerns the use, manufacture and trade of such equipment pursuant to Section 11, paragraph 2 of the Radiation Act and the activities related to this.

This decision repeals section 8 of the Radiation and Nuclear Safety Authority's earlier decision 147/310/95 (24 February 1995).
